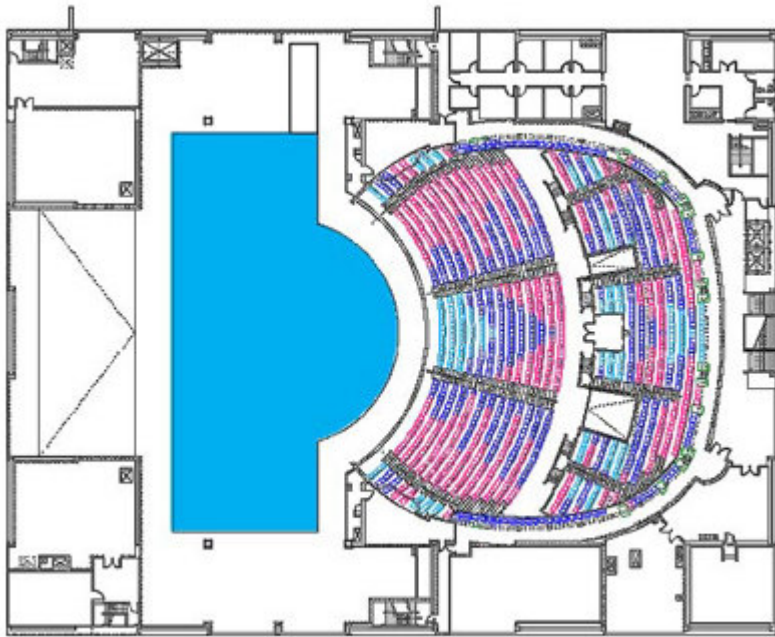


## Sceno Plus

Sceno Plus' is a company which specializes in architectural and theatrical design. They do everything from designing the theatre to rigging the systems within it. Founded in 1985, their ambitious team of designers and technicians all work towards a vision that they call Technology Art Passion. Sceno Plus' has designed and coordinated projects on several of the most popular entertainment venues today, such as the theatre where Cirque du Soleil's "O" is performed. In fact, Sceno Plus' is responsible for designing several of Cirque du Soleil's performance spaces. In addition to designing for the Cirque, they have also completed projects in Montreal (where their firm is established), and Europe (they also have offices in Paris, France). Having completed over 30 projects in Quebec and several in the United States, Sceno Plus has created an "international presence" for itself. Among performing arts facilities they all have also designed sports and games facilities, TV and Cineplex studios, and recreation and tourist facilities. The last project that Sceno Plus' completed was in March 2003. The show "A New Day" premiered at The Colosseum at Caesar's Palace in Las Vegas. The Colosseum is a 4000 seat showroom, which hailed excellent reviews.
